Guideline for Residual Solvents Q3C(R7) - there is potential for Class II and III solvents to be present in P4C5Z-027. INVISTA Polypropylene believes if these solvents to be present will be well below the concentration limit set in the Guideline for Residual Solvents Q3C(R7). INVISTA Polypropylene recommends having the material tested for confirmation.

None of the following elements are intentionally used in the formulation of P4C5Z-027: Cd, Pb, As, Hg, Co, V, Ni, Tl, Au, Pd, Ir, Os, Rh, Ru, Se, Ag, Pt, Li, Sb, Ba, Mo, Cu, Sn, or Cr. INVISTA Polypropylene does not test each raw material or product we produce for these elements.

As with any material, evaluation under end-use conditions is essential.
