This letter is in response to your request for information on the BASF product(s) listed above.

To the best of our knowledge, based on the information provided by our raw material suppliers plus knowledge of our finished product compositions, the BASF products listed herein do not intentionally contain Per- or Polyfluoroalkyl Substances (PFAS):

- Defined by § 705.3 of EPA's TSCA Section 8(a)(7) Final Rule as: "any chemical substance or mixture containing a chemical substance that structurally contains at least one of the following three sub-structures:
 - (1) R-(CF₂)-CF(R')R", where both the CF₂ and CF moieties are saturated carbons.
 - (2) R-CF₂OCF₂-R', where R and R' can either be F, O, or saturated carbons.
 - (3) CF₃C(CF₃)R'R", where R' and R" can either be F or saturated carbons"
