This letter is in response to your request from INV Polypropylene, LLC (INVISTA Polypropylene) to provide you with information as it relates to the polypropylene product P4C5Z-027.

None of the persistent organic pollutants listed below are intentionally used in the formulation of P4C5Z-027. The list of persistent organic pollutants is as follows: Tetrabromodiphenyl ether, Pentabromodiphenyl ether, Hexabromodiphenyl ether, Heptabromodiphenyl ether, Bis(pentabromophenyl) ether, Decabromodiphenyl ether, Perfluorooctane sulfonic acid and its derivatives (PFOS), Perfluorooctanoic acid (PFOA), its salts and PFOA-related compounds, DDT (1,1,1-trichloro-2,2-bis (4-chlorophenyl)ethane), Chlordane, Hexachlorocyclohexanes, including Lindane, Dieldrin, Endrin, Dicofol, Heptachlor, Endosulfan, Hexachlorobenzene, Chlordane, Aldrin, Pentachlorobenzene, Polychlorinated Biphenyls (PCB), Mirex, Toxaphene, Hexabromobiphenyl, 1 Hexabromocyclododecane, Hexachlorobutadiene, Polychlorinated dibenzodioxins and dibenzofurans, Pentachlorophenol and its salts and esters, Polychlorinated naphthalenes, Alkanes C10-C13, chloro (short-chain chlorinated paraffins - SCCPs), medium-chain chlorinated paraffins (MCCP), Methoxychlor, Dechlorane Plus (CAS 13560-89-9, CAS 135821-03-3, or CAS 135821-74-8), and UV-328 (CAS 25973-55-1). INVISTA Polypropylene does not test each raw material or product we produce for these substances.
